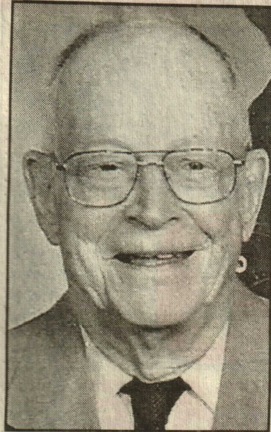


EHKKE, Marvin Edward ^{died} 15 Jul 2007

Marvin Edward Ehlke

Marvin is survived by his daughter, Kathy and Tom Old and Grandchildren, Jessica and Richard Trump, Stephanie, Timothy and Karen Old and three great-granddaughters-Hope, Faith and Grace. A Memorial Service was held on Sunday, July 22nd, 2007 at Whitney United Methodist Church in Boise. Marvin was interred at All Faith's Memorial Park in Tucson on Friday, September 21st, 2007 at a small family gathering.
